GENERAL RULES

COMPETITORS ENTER UNDER THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE SURREY FESTIVAL OF DANCE SOCIETY AND MUST ADHERE TO THESE RULES. PLEASE READ NEW AND REVISED INFORMATION.

NOTE: AN ASTERISK DENOTES CHANGES IN THE SYLLABUS.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. The accepted age in all classes shall be as of December 31st of the previous year. The birthdates, mailing address, and phone number of all dancers must be listed on entry form.
- 2. All classes shall be open to amateurs and semi-professionals only, Dance Teacher(s) are not allowed to compete, but may enter class for adjudication only. The term "amateur" and "semi-professional" shall mean one whose principal income is not derived from teaching or performing services.
- 3. <u>SEMI-PROFESSIONAL:</u> Any individual, student, student-teacher or group who has worked in a singing and/or dancing capacity and has received any type of remuneration (goods, services, cash) valued at over two thousand and five hundred dollars per calendar year. Any dancer or group who has found to have worked as a semi-professional after being awarded scholarships or being asked to represent Surrey Festival of Dance as a Provincial Rep or Runner Up will be required to return said scholarship(s) and/or step down as Provincial Rep or Runner Up. Dancers working as actors only (not including dancing and/or singing) are not governed by these rules. Any questions regarding semi-professional status must be presented to Surrey Festival of Dance and final decisions of the Board of Directors and the Section Head are final.
- 4. <u>STUDENT-TEACHER</u> is considered an amateur as long as a <u>professional dance teacher is in the same room</u>

 75 % of the time; while he/she is teaching. *Student/Dance Teacher(s)* are not allowed to compete but may enter class <u>for adjudication only</u>.
- 5. To avoid any confusion: a routine performed by a SOLO ENTRANT must not be used AGAIN by the same student in any class in the current or subsequent year either alone or with the addition of a partner as in a Duo, Trio, or Group entry. Minor changes in patterning of choreography DOES NOT constitute a different dance.
- 6. Dancer is allowed to enter <u>only once in a solo, duo or trio class</u>, even though they may be registered with more than one Studio/Teacher. (EXCEPTION: Student Teacher Choreography Classes.) **Multiple entries will be permitted in any group age category.**
- 7. **GROUPS** Name, age and birth date of each dancer <u>must</u> be listed on the entry form. Class eligibility will be determined by the group's <u>average age</u>. NOTE: When calculating the average age 0.51 and over is advanced to the next higher age group. (i.e.: Average age of 8.50 enters in the 8-year age group. Average age is 8.51 enter in the 9-year age group). <u>DUOS OR TRIOS AGE OF THE OLDEST</u> determines the class.
- 8. <u>A NOVICE</u> is an ENTRANT who has not had more than 2 years of <u>ANY FORM OF DANCE</u>. All entries must be marked <u>NOVICE</u> and <u>SIGNED BY THE TEACHER</u>.
- 9. **A GROUP** must consist of four (4) or more and ALL dancers must participate equally in the choreography. All Dancers must be registered on entry form. **If number of dancers exceed number registered a \$50.00 fine will be assessed & payable prior to adjudication**. If the fine is not paid, the group will go for adjudication only. See group classification for each Dance Discipline. **Student/Dance Teacher(s)** are not allowed to compete but may enter class *for adjudication only*.
- 10. A source/origin must be given for all INTERNATIONAL DANCE CATEGORIES.
- 11. **TIMING OF PERFORMANCE WILL BE DETERMINED BY FESTIVAL STOPWATCHES ONLY**. Timing will begin at the START of the music OR the first movements of the dancer on stage (depending on which starts first) until the dancer(s) have left the stage permanently. Timing strictly enforced Marks will be deducted which will affect ultimate placement. See special timing for International Section only.
- 12. A Solo, Duo, or Trio must not be longer than three (3) minutes. A group must not exceed five (5) minutes. **EXCEPTION**: Studio Productions (Class 554), Musical Theatre (Class 560) must not exceed fifteen (15) minutes; Solo Variation en Pointe classes, Male Classical Variation classes, AND Pas De Deux classes Five (5) minutes. Pas de Trois, Quatre or Cinq classes Ten (10) minutes. Group Classical Repertoire classes Ten (10) minutes. (See Eligibility Rule #11).
- 13. ALL CHOREOGRAPHY NOTES: Notes must include Name, Class #, Section and Age. Choreography notes represent 50% of mark. Choreography notes MUST BE in prior to commencement of each discipline in which dance is to be performed, failure will result in disqualification. IF MAILED TO OFFICE, MUST BE IN PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF THE FESTIVAL. NOTES MUST INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

 Cover Page: Name, Age, Dance Section, and Class Number. Page 2 Title of Dance, Music Choice and by whom, Synopsis of Choreography and what motivated you. (i.e.: why this selection of music, etc). Page 3 Floor Plan (Start to Finish) Page 4 your choreography with counts. Be clear in your stage direction (down Stage right, Upstage left, etc) additional information Costume, Makeup, possible lighting cues and or stage set, prop. etc. (Optional)

- 14. <u>INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC ONLY</u> –in any class in the BALLET SECTION. (EXCEPTION: Demi-character Classes 181 only (6 years & under); Demi -Characters groups and Contemporary Ballet.).
- 15. MUSIC MUST BE DOWNLOADED TO SFD GOOGLE DRIVE Link will be provided by Surrey Festival of dance once all entries are completed, must be a MP3. IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED YOU HAVE A BACK UP on a USB flash drive or downloaded on cell phone, computer.
- 16. **SONG & DANCE** Instrumental Music only allowed when vocalizing. NO LIP SYNCHRONIZATION PERMITTED. **TAP CLASSES** NO TAP SOUNDS may be heard on tape.
- 17. <u>IN ALL DANCE CATEGORIES</u>, at least 90% of steps & style must be in the discipline entered. Exception (AcroDance 50% dance/ 50% Acro elements)
- 18. PROPS: <u>SEE INDIVIDUAL DANCE CATEGORY FOR FURTHER DETAILS</u> The proper must be light enough for a dancer or designated person to carry on and off stage. Must have proper dance/stage floor protection. If dance stage floor is damaged as a result of misused or props not properly protected, studio/school will be liable for all damages occurred. No dragging or sliding across dance/stage floor. No props can be projected into audience from stage or during performance. (Will result in disqualification).
- 19. To comply with the B.C. PROVINCIAL COMPETITION, the dancers must receive a mark of 85 or higher to qualify for provincials.
- 20. <u>PROVINCIAL REPRESENTATIVE</u>: To Qualify:
 - <u>Contemporary/Modern Representative</u> a dancer must perform a Solo Modern & Solo Contemporary DANCER MUST attend workshop class #2280, 2281, or 2282.
 - <u>Ballet Representative</u> a dancer must perform solo set/solo variation set, and a minimum of one (ages 13 20 years), or (ages 10 12 years) minimum of two other solos (i.e.: Variation en Pointe, Male Variation, Open Demi-character, Demi-Pointe/Pointe, Pointe, Interpretive, and Contemporary Ballet). **DANCERMUST attend audition class #2270, 2272 or 2275.**
 - <u>Stage Representative Jazz</u> a dancer must perform either a Solo Jazz or Lyrical, and two other solos (i.e.: Tap, Stage, Song & Dance AcroDance or Hip Hop/Street Dance). **DANCER MUST attend audition class#796, 797 or 798.**
 - <u>Stage Representative -Tap</u> a dancer must perform a Solo Tap and two other solos (i.e.: Stage, Song & Dance, Open Jazz, Lyrical, AcroDance or Hip Hop/Street Dance). **DANCER MUST attend audition class563, 564 or 565.**
- 21. LIP SYNCING Not permitted in any category: Exceptions Stage and Hip Hop Categories only.

ENTRIES

- All entries become the property of the SURREY FESTIVAL OF DANCE SOCIETY. ALL FEES ARE
 NON-REFUNDABLE: including cancellation and withdrawals. Surrey Festival of Dance reserves the right to refuse entries.
- 2. In Group performances <u>please specify dance title on entry form</u>, as names of dance schools will not be printed in the programme. All solo entrants must have home mailing address, home phone numbers, as well as studio phone numbers on entry form.
- 3. Solo Variation en Pointe & Male Variation must enter the solo ballet set for age requirement and must have title listed on entry form. (See class 53, 54, 55, 56 69 &70 for clarification)
- 4. Pas de Trois, Quatre, Cinq must have title listed on entry form. (See Classes 86, 87, 88 & 89, for clarification.)
- 5. Check your entry confirmations carefully; no changes will be accepted after January 30. (Also Check Procedure Rule #17)

TROPHIES

- 1. All engraving is the responsibility of the Trophy Winner.
- 2. Trophies/medal/medallion are awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator.
- 3. TROPHIES MUST BE RETURNED BY <u>JANUARY 15th</u> OF EACH YEAR. The STUDIO/RECIPIENT is <u>financially</u> <u>responsible</u> for returning the trophy in good condition. Trophies must not be taken apart when being shipped back to the office.
- 4. Anyone interested in donating to the Scholarship Fund, donating a trophy/plaque, or becoming a Patron, please contacts the Festival Office.
- 5. All Trophies & plaques donated become the property of the Surrey Festival of Dance Society.

PROCEDURES

- 1. Competitors must be *PREPARED TO DANCE twenty* (20) minutes prior to the given time and report <u>TO THE STAGE</u> **DOOR PRIOR TO COMMENCEMENT OF THE CLASS.**
- 2. No late competitor(s) may perform after the class has been adjudicated.
- 3. Competitors are allowed to practice in DESIGNATED areas only. Main Stage & wings are not a practice area.
- 4. **COMPETITOR(S) MUST NOT BE COACHED WHILE PERFORMING. Exception:** in classes under SIX (6) years of age. **Teachers may stand behind curtain and in wings to assist with coaching of these students.** COMPETITORS, TEACHERS AND DESIGNATED HELP ONLY ALLOWED BACKSTAGE AND MUST NOT STAND BEHIND CURTAINS.
- 5. **ALL PROTESTS** must be in writing to the Festival Office before the end of May, accompanied by Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars. In the event, of the protest being sustained, the Twenty-five (\$25.00) will be refunded. The decision of the committee is final.
- 6. <u>ABSOLUTELY NO DISCUSSION WITH THE ADJUDICATOR</u> by teachers, dancers or parents.
- 7. Solo, Duo and Trio participants shall pick up adjudication sheets and certificates in the lobby. Group adjudication sheets will be given to Teachers <u>ONLY</u> backstage. They will be mailed out if not picked up. <u>**DO NOT SEND**</u> **PARENTS/OTHERS.**
- 8. Certificates may be awarded <u>AT THE DISCRETION OF THE ADJUDICATOR</u> to 1ST, 2ND, &3RD place winners in each class who have achieved a mark of 80% or over. Preschool to 9 years receive gold, silver or bronze ribbons.
- 9. <u>SURREY FESTIVAL OF DANCE PROVINCIAL REPRESENTATIVES, AWARDS</u> and <u>HONOUR AWARDS ARE SELECTED BY THE ADJUDICATORS.</u>
- 10. <u>ALL TAP SHOES</u> must be covered or removed before and after each performance. Any article that could damage the stage will not be permitted. <u>Teachers and competitors must ensure that Tap Shoes can pass inspection.</u>
- 11. Competitors please be respectful and remain in assigned seats until adjudications are finished.
- 12. PHOTOGRAPHY: ABSOLUTELYNOELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT of any kind may be used by the audience, teachers and competitors. (i.e.: cameras, video equipment, recording devices, cell phones, pagers, I-Pods, Blackberry, Palm Pilots, Game boys, etc.) All electronic devices must be turned off. (i.e.: cell phones, etc.) EXCEPTION: AUTHORIZED MEDIA ONLY.
- 13. No adjustment of any curtains permitted (refer to class 554 & 560).
- 14. No part of any dance may start or end from off the front of the stage/audience/stairways. (i.e. No starting or ending dance from audience.) No props can be projected into audience from stage or during performance. Due to safety issues this will result in disqualification.
- 15. **BEHAVIOR & BACKSTAGE ETIQUETTE:** Individuals will be asked to leave the Theatre/Backstage area if, in the opinion of the Festival Committee or its members, they are behaving in a manner not fitted to a Dance Competition of this nature. This will apply to competitors, teachers and members of the audience.
- 16. No substitution of competitors will be allowed <u>UNLESS</u> approved before the commencement of the Dance Section in which dance is to be performed. REQUESTS MUST BE IN WRITING, MAILED, FAXED OR EMAILED TO THE FESTIVAL OFFICE. Festival Committee must approve all requests.
- 17. <u>DANCE-OFF REQUESTS</u> will be considered at the discretion of the Surrey Festival of Dance.
- 18. The Festival is a family event. All choreography and content must be appropriate for family audiences. Inappropriate language, songs, costuming and gestures will NOT be permitted.
- 19. **Liability Waiver**

The Surrey Festival of Dance Society (SFD) is not responsible for any claims, demands or damages concerning injury to any competitor that may occur during the annual SFD Festival. SFD will not be responsible for any loss or damage to props, or any other personal property. SFD's acceptance of a competitor's application for entry into the SFD Festival, will release any responsibility of SFD or volunteers for SFD, from claims, demands, damages, actions or causes of action arising out of or in consequence of any loss, injury or damage to any competitor or any competitor's personal property incurred while attending or participating in the Surrey Festival of Dance Festival.

BALLET

<u>PLEASE READ ALL RULES & REGULATIONS ON PAGES 2-4 CAREFULLY, taking special note of additional Rules and Procedures listed hereunder:</u>

- 1. Except for Solo Demi-Character, Interpretive & Contemporary Ballet classes, all Ballet students must first enter Solo Set Dances/Solo Set Variation Dances as their first dance. If Solo Set Dance/Solo Set Variation Dance is not entered, all other classes entered will be for adjudication only.
- 2. Except for Solo Set Dance/Solo Set Variation Dance, and classical classes, all other classes must be teachers' own choreography. (Example: no classical variations in Solo Ballet, Demi-Character, etc.).

3. PROVINCIAL BALLET REPRESENTATIVE:

- **Junior Provincial Ballet Representative** must perform a solo set and a **MINIMUM** of two other solos to show versatility. Dancer must attend Audition Class to be considered (#2270).
- <u>Intermediate and Senior Provincial Ballet Representatives</u> must perform a solo variation set and a <u>MINIMUM</u> of one other solo to show versatility. Dancer must attend Audition Class to be considered (#2272 and #2275).

4. <u>Junior Solo Set Dances and Intermediate/Senior Solo Set Variation Dances - DVD, Music & Notes on CD must be obtained through SFD Office.</u>

- <u>Junior Solo Set Dances</u> (Classes 1-8). Female and male dances are all on DVD. Set dances must be performed as indicated on video and choreography notes. No Embellishments. Class # must be on entry form. The deadline for changes is January 30th. No Changes will be permitted once confirmation has been mailed. Dress Code: See Rule #5.
- <u>Intermediate/Senior Solo Set Variation Dance</u> (Classes 9-15). To ensure fairness and standardization to all competitors, all music and notes on all 21 Variations are on a CD prepared by SFD. Competitors must choose a version danced by a major dance company. Male Variation age 13-15 are given an option of dancing to the original variations by a major ballet company or you can dance the simplified version which is provided in our CD package. Class # must be on entry form. Solo Set Variation cannot be used again by the same dancer in all Variation en Pointe Classes in this current dance year. The deadline for changes is January 30th. No changes will be permitted once confirmation has been mailed. Dress Code: See Rule # 5.

5. Solo Set & Solo Set Variation Dress Code: Marks will be deducted if dress code is not followed.

- Leotard: Must be of Classical Style (one plain colour of same material, no fancy trim or multiple straps, etc.) and pink tights. Male: White T-shirt & solid coloured tights.
- ½" or ¼" elastic waistband optional. Ballet slippers/Pointe shoes.
- ABSOLUTELY no jewelry, hair ornaments, etc. Exception: 1/4" wide hair ribbon and/or small ear studs.
- 6. **SOLO ENTRANT** (See General Eligibility rules #5 and #6)
- 7. **SHOES:** must be worn in all classes. **BAREFEET** are not allowed in any classes, including interpretive and contemporary ballet.
- 8. **PROPS:** ONLY one simple prop per dancer is allowed in Demi Character or Contemporary Ballet. The prop must be used as an integral part of the routine. Prop is not allowed in any other classes except for the classes mentioned above. For any other classes regarding an integral handheld prop consideration please contact Ballet Section Head.
- 9. **STAGING**-not allowed in any classes.
- 10. <u>TITLES:</u> Must be entered on all Classical Variation Classes, Demi Character Classes, Interpretive Classes, Pas de Deux, Pas de Trois, Quatre, Cinq, Group Classical Repertoire Classes and all Groups.

11. <u>MUSIC:</u> ONLY Instrumental music is allowed in all ballet classes except for Contemporary Ballet & Demi Character (age 6 and under) where vocals and lyrics are allowed.

MUSIC MUST BE DOWNLOADED TO SFD GOOGLE DRIVE - Link will be provided by Surrey Festival of dance once all entries are completed, must be a MP3. <u>IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED YOU HAVE A BACK</u> <u>UP on a USB flash drive or downloaded on cell phone, computer.</u> (See General Rules #15)

12. **TIMING:**

- Solo, Duo, Trio maximum 3 minutes
- Solo Variations, Pas de Deux maximum 5 minutes
- Pas de Trois, Quatre & Cinq, Group Classical Repertoire maximum 10 minutes
- Groups Maximum 5 minutes
- 13. **CHOREOGRAPHY NOTES:** Must be handed in prior to the commencement of the Ballet section. (See General Rules #13 for further information).
- **14**. **DANCE-OFF REQUESTS** will be considered at the discretion of the Surrey Festival of Dance. (See Procedure Rules #17)
- 15. <u>LIP SYNCING</u> Not permitted in any category: Exceptions Stage and Hip Hop Categories only. (See General Rules #21)
- 16. All ballet competitors must also comply with SFD General Rules and Procedures.

The Junior Solo Set Dance DVD, music CD and choreography notes may be obtained from the Surrey Festival of Dance office for an administration fee of Fifty dollars (\$50.00) per set.

*Please ensure your studio has exchanged the original Junior Solo Set Package (2019) with the replacement package for Classes 1-8, which was done in July 2020. Replacement package reflects changes in Classes 3, 4 & 6 (ages 7, 8 & 10 years old). Please contact SFD office for free exchanges.

The Solo Set Dances Girls (Classes 1-5) and Boys (Classes 1-3) have been choreographed by Kelly Bale. The Solo Set Dances Girls (Classes 6-8) and Boys (Classes 4-8) have been choreographed by Johanne Gingras. Therefore, performances of any of them at other festivals, recitals, etc. are **prohibited** except by permission of the Surrey Festival of Dance and a \$10.00 fee.

The Intermediate/Senior Solo Set Variation Music, and Male Variation Notes for 13-15 years may be obtained from the Surrey Festival of Dance office for an administration fee of (\$50.00) The simplified choreography for the Male Variation (13 to 15 years) has been provided by Christopher Hird based on the Royal Ballet.

PROVINCIAL BALLET AUDITION CLASSES: - Dancers that performed in their allocated Solo Set Dance/Solo Set Variation Dance along with the minimum required solo classes will be automatically registered at no cost for the audition class where adjudicator will choose provincial representatives to represent SFD at Performing Arts BC. Students must attend class to qualify for Provincials Provincial Ballet Audition Classes, Dress Code: See Ballet Rule #5

<u>CLASS</u> 2270	MALE Dancers who are registered in solo set ballet Classes 6 – 8 along with a minimum of two other dance forms in the following classes: solo ballet open demi-pointe #36-38, solo male classical variation #62, solo demi-character #185-187, solo interpretive #302-304, solo contemporary ballet #2069-2071.
2272	Dancers who are registered in solo set variation ballet Classes 9 – 12 along with a minimum of two other dance forms in the following classes: solo ballet open demi-pointe #39-41, solo male classical variation #69& 73, solo demi-character #188-190, solo interpretive #305-307, solo contemporary ballet #2075-2077.

ACRODANCE

PLEASE READ ALL RULES & REGULATIONS ON PAGES 2-4 CAREFULLY, taking special note of additional Rules and Procedures listed hereunder:

<u>ACRODANCE</u>: routine that combines classical dance technique (Ballet, Jazz, etc.); with flexibility along with precision acrobatic elements that appears to seamlessly blend the two mediums together within a dance context.

Routine must contain <u>50% DANCE and 50% acrobatic elements</u> that are appropriate for age and level of training. Routines cannot begin, end, or proceed off stage into the audience level at any time. All acrobatic skills and dance should be performed in safe manner. Footwear is recommended but is not required.

- 1. A Dancer is allowed to enter only once in a solo class, even though they may be registered with more than one Studio/Teacher. Multiple entries will be permitted in any group age category. (See Eligibility #6)
- 2. All participants must be supervised during routine.
- 3. Groups must have a minimum of four (4) members. Timing strictly enforced. (See Eligibility Rule #11, also Procedure Rule #14)
- 4. Prop: a simple standing prop may be used as integral part of routine. (i.e.: chairs, stools, benches, etc.) No flames, sharp pointed objects, mats. Wearable and hand-held prop is allowed. Prop MUST be light enough for a dancer or a designated person to carry on or off stage. If unsure about prop, contact appropriate Section Head. All props MUST have proper dance/stage floor protection. If dance stage floor is damaged as a result of misused or props not properly protected, studio/school will be liable for all damages occurred. No dragging or sliding across dance/stage floor. No props can be projected into audience from stage or during performance. Due to safety issues, this will result in disqualification. (See Eligibility Rule #18)
- 5. Drops from knee, thigh, seat, front, back, jazz split (hurdler) or split position onto the performing surface from a turn, jump, stand or inverted position must first have proper weight on hands or foot/feet in order to break the impact of the drop.
- 6. Pyramids are prohibited. Exception, pony sit, thigh stand and shoulder sit.
- 7. TIMING OF PERFORMANCE WILL BE DETERMINED BY FESTIVAL STOPWATCHES ONLY. Timing will begin at the START of the music OR the first movements of the dancer on stage (5 depending on which starts first) until the dancer(s) have left the stage permanently. Timing strictly enforced Marks will be deducted which will affect ultimate placement.
- 8. **MUSIC MUST BE DOWNLOADED TO SFD GOOGLE DRIVE -** Link will be provided by Surrey Festival of dance once all entries are completed, must be a MP3. <u>IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED YOU HAVE A BACK UP on a USB flash drive or downloaded on cell phone, computer.</u> (See General Rules #15)
- 9. The Festival is a family event all choreography and content must be appropriate for family audiences. Inappropriate language, songs, costuming and gestures will NOT be permitted.
- 10. All participants should have emergency plan in event of an injury.
- 11. Groups: a lift/supporting dancer must maintain direct contact with the stage at all times.
- 12. No part of any dance may start or end from off the front of the stage/audience/stairways. (See Procedure Rule #14)
- 13. **LIP SYNCING** Not permitted in any category: Exceptions Stage and Hip Hop Categories only. (See General Rules #21)
- 14. **DANCE-OFF REQUESTS** will be considered at the discretion of the Surrey Festival of Dance. (See Procedure Rules #17)

- 1. All classes shall be open to amateurs and semi-professionals only, Dance Teacher(s) are not allowed to compete, but may enter class for adjudication only. The term "amateur" and "semi-professional" shall mean one whose principal income is not derived from teaching or performing services. (See Eligibility Rule #2)
- 2. <u>STUDENT-TEACHER</u> is considered an amateur as long as <u>a professional dance teacher is in the same room 75% of the time while he/she is teaching.</u> (See Eligibility Rule #4) *Student/Dance Teacher(s)* are not allowed to compete but may enter class *for adjudication only*.
- 3. To avoid any confusion: a routine performed by a SOLO ENTRANT must not be used AGAIN by the same student in any class in the current or subsequent year either alone or with the addition of a partner as in a Duo, Trio, or Group entry. Minor changes in patterning of choreography DOES NOT constitute a different dance. (See Eligibility Rule #5)
- 4. A Dancer is allowed to enter <u>only once in a solo class</u>, even though they may be registered with more than one Studio/Teacher. (EXCEPTION: Student Teacher Choreography Classes.) **Multiple entries will be permitted in any group age category.** (See Eligibility Rule #6)
- 5. **GROUPS** Name, age and birth date of each dancer <u>must</u> be listed on the entry form. Class eligibility will be determined by the group's <u>average age</u>. NOTE: When calculating the average age 0.51 and over is advanced to the next higher age group. (i.e.: Average ages of 8.50 enter in the 8 year age group. Average age is 8.51 enter in the 9 year age group.) <u>DUOS OR</u> TRIOS AGE OF THE OLDEST determines the class.)(See Eligibility Rule #7)
- 6. <u>A NOVICE</u> is an <u>ENTRANT</u> who has not had more than 2 years of <u>ANY FORM OF DANCE</u>. All entries must be marked <u>NOVICE</u> and <u>SIGNED BY THE TEACHER</u>. (See Eligibility Rule #8)
- 7. **A GROUP** must consist of four (4) or more and ALL dancers must participate equally in the choreography. All dancers must be registered on entry form. **If number of dancers exceed number registered a \$50.00 fine will be assessed & payable prior to adjudication**. If the fine is not paid, the group will go for adjudication only. (See Eligibility Rule #9) **Student/Dance Teacher(s)** are not allowed to compete but may enter class *for adjudication only*.
- 8. TIMING OF PERFORMANCE WILL BE DETERMINED BY FESTIVAL STOPWATCHES ONLY. Timing will begin at the START of the music OR the first movements of the dancer on stage (depending on which starts first) until the dancer(s) have left the stage permanently. Timing strictly enforced Marks will be deducted which will affect ultimate placement. See special timing for International Section only.
- 9. A Solo, Duo, or Trio must not be longer than three (3) minutes. A group must not exceed five (5) minutes. **EXCEPTION**: Studio Productions (Class 554), Musical Theatre (Class 560) must not exceed fifteen (15) minutes, Solo Variation en Pointe, (Class 55 & 56), Male Classical Variation, (Class 70), AND Pas De Deux (Classes 80, 85, 88 & 89), Ten (10) minutes. Group Classical Repertoire Class 170 177 ten (10) minutes (See Eligibility Rule #11).

- All classes shall be open to amateurs and semi-professionals only; Dance Teacher(s) are not allowed to compete but may enter class for adjudication only. The term "amateur" and "semi-professional" shall mean-one whose principal income is not derived from teaching or performing services.
- 2 <u>STUDENT-TEACHER</u> is considered an amateur as long as <u>a professional dance teacher is in the same room</u>

 75 % of the time whilst he/she is teaching. **Student/Dance Teacher(s)** are not allowed to compete but may enter class <u>for</u>

In the International category, it is important to note that *NO SINGLE ADJUDICATOR CAN BE PROFICIENT IN ALL FORMS OF DANCE*. However, most have an extensive background in many forms of dance and this will assist in evaluating these entries. *THE UTMOST RESPECT IS DUE THOSE ADJUDICATORS FOR TAKING ON THE TASK OF JUDGING THIS CATEGORY*.

- 1. <u>AGE DIVISIONS</u>
 - Junior 12 years & under: Intermediate 13- 15 years; Senior 16 20 years; Adult 21 years & over (See Eligibility Rule #6)
- 2. International Dance Categories Country of origin must be listed on entry form
- 3. Dance category description:
 - A) **TRADITIONAL**: in keeping with authentic dance tradition of a country using classical steps.
 - B) <u>FOLK</u> folkloric traditions of an indigenous culture and/or heritage among people of a nation or region.
 - C) <u>INTERNATIONAL CONTEMPORARY</u>: A choreographic arrangement incorporating modern themes and influences with traditional elements. (Not to be confused with Contemporary/Modern Section.)
- 4. <u>TIMING FOR INTERNATIONAL SECTION ONLY</u>: Solo, Duo &Trio Maximum 5 minutes. GROUPS: Maximum 8 minutes, Studio Presentation Maximum 15 minutes. (See Eligibility Rule #11) **TIMING OF PERFORMANCE**WILL BE DETERMINED BY FESTIVAL STOPWATCHES ONLY. Timing will begin at the START of the music OR the first movements of the dancer(s) on stage (depending on which starts first) until the dancer(s) have left the stage permanently. If the time limit is exceeded, marks will be deducted which will affect ultimate placement. Timing strictly enforced Marks will be deducted which will affect ultimate placement.
- 5. **PROP:** A Simple prop may be used and must be an integral part of the routine. If unsure about prop, contact appropriate Section Head. Prop MUST be light enough for a dancer or a designated person to carry on or off stage. **PROP MUST have proper dance/stage floor protection.** If dance stage floor is damaged as a result of misused or props not properly protected, studio/school will be liable for all damages occurred. No dragging or sliding across dance/stage floor. No props can be projected into audience from stage or during performance. Due to safety issues, this will result in disqualification. (See Eligibility Rule #18)
- 6. **SPECIAL RULES**
 - 1. **LIVE MUSICAL ACCOMPANIMENT** (up to 4 musicians' maximum) is allowed in any International dance category only. Music chosen must be appropriate to dance piece.
 - 2. **Lifting of dancers allowed**. In a lift the supporting dancer must maintain direct contact with the stage at all times. No starting or ending dance from audience.
 - 3. **Costume**: must be appropriate for theme presented.
- 7. MUSIC MUST BE DOWNLOADED TO SFD GOOGLE DRIVE Link will be provided by Surrey Festival of dance once all entries are completed, must be a MP3. <u>IT IS STRONGLY RECOMMENDED YOU HAVE A BACK UP on a USB flash drive or downloaded on cell phone, computer.</u> (See General Rules #15)
- 8. he Festival is a family event all choreography and content must be appropriate for family audiences. Inappropriate language, songs, costuming and gestures will NOT be permitted.
- 9. PHOTOGRAPHY: ABSOLUTELY NO ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT of any kind may be used by the audience, teachers and competitors. (i.e.: cameras, video equipment, recording devices, cell phones, pagers, I-pods, Blackberry, palm pilots, gameboys, etc.) All electronic devices must be turned off. (i.e.: cell phones, etc.) EXCEPTION: AUTHORIZED MEDIA ONLY.
- 10. No substitution of competitors will be allowed <u>UNLESS</u> approved before the commencement of the Dance Section in which dance is to be performed. REQUESTS MUST BE IN WRITING/FAXED AND **RECEIVED** AT THE FESTIVAL OFFICE. Festival Committee must approve all requests.

<u>Dancers must be ready to perform 20 minutes prior to their class start time.</u> Competitors who do not hand in their music or fail to be ready at this time will be considered ABSENT. As a courtesy, please report any cancellations as soon as possible.


